**NOTICE TO ALL EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED
UNDER THE BCCFU MASTER AGREEMENT:**

Re: Actsafe Motion Picture Safety Awareness Course Eligibility

Article 12.07 of the BCCFU Master Agreement requires employees employed under the British Columbia Master Agreement or Supplemental Master Agreement to successfully complete the Actsafe Motion Picture Safety Awareness course before March 31, 2024. However, the Article does not specify which version(s) of the course would satisfy the requirements of Article 12.07. The content, format and name of the course have changed multiple times over many years.

The Negotiating Parties (the AMPTP, CMPA, and BCCFU) wish to clarify that the version of the course available during the term of the 2018-2021 Agreement, and any subsequent version of the course, are considered to satisfy the requirements of Article 12.07. For greater clarity, successful completion on or after August 25, 2015 of either the Actsafe Motion Picture Safety Awareness course or the Actsafe Safety 101 course will meet the requirement under Article 12.07.

Any Employee who completed a version of the Actsafe Motion Picture Safety Awareness course prior to August 25, 2015 will have until June 30, 2024 to take the current version of the course in order to meet the requirements of Article 12.07.
