



PGK & CMPA MOU

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Producers Guild of Korea (PGK) and the Canadian Media Producers Association (CMPA) have agreed on the following memorandum of understanding outlining steps to build a sustainable partnership to promote international co-production and cultural exchange between the Canadian and Korean film and media production sectors.

Agenda

- The two organizations shall act as the primary point of contact to discuss the foundational requirements for international co-production opportunities between Canada and Korea.
- The two organizations will collaborate to promote the value of a modernized co-production treaty with appropriate industry and government stakeholders and promote it to the broader public.
- The two organizations will actively explore co-production opportunities through exchange programs such as annual meetings and showcases in Canada or Korea, and work together to maintain a sustainable ecosystem for the global film industry in the future.

Term

This MOU is signed on December 17, 2025, and shall be effective from the date of signing. The period of validity shall be automatically extended annually unless terminated by either organization.

This MOU represents the first step towards a working relationship between the CMPA and PGK as a commitment to an open dialogue and exchange of information, which will lead to a stronger role for the producer in the global industry, and is not legally binding. This MOU shall be executed in two (2) copies in Korean and English, and two (2) copies shall be kept by each organization.
